

Operation of Golf Carts on Tiki Island

1. Licensed driver
2. Slow Moving Emblem with reflective surface
3. D.O.T. approved operational head lamps
4. D.O.T. approved operational tail lamps
5. D.O.T. approved side reflectors
6. Rearview Mirror(s)
7. Operational parking brake
8. No driving on walking/bicycle lane on Tiki Dr.
9. Drive with the flow of traffic
11. Liability insurance (optional)
12. Children under the age of seven shall be restrained by either an adult or by a seatbelt.
13. Golf carts are prohibited from pulling trailers, boats, jet skis, other objects or people on public streets and the right of way.
14. Headlights shall be used when dark.
15. Passengers shall be limited to designated seating capacity by manufacturer.
16. No one shall stand in or on the vehicle while it is in operation.
17. All golf carts shall be registered with the Village and have attached an annual registration sticker issued by the City upon payment of a \$25.00 registration fee.
18. All drivers of golf carts shall abide by all traffic regulations applicable to vehicular traffic when using the authorized streets.

All traffic laws apply Day or Night. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a golf cart on a public street in violation of these provisions.
